### City Council Update & Recap

Much of the Council's work last month revolved around the City's 2021 budget. After four working sessions and two Council meetings covering the budget, I voted in favor the measure. More on the budget, can be found [here](#).

The Council also considered the following measures since the last update:

- Approval of a vehicle service facility (Belle Tire) north of Kahlo
- A rezoning for the construction of an HSE elementary school at 156th St. and Boden Rd.

- An update to the City's employee manual
- A resolution regarding the Cityscape/Nexus Project on the old Marsh property (for questions here, I'd encourage you to reference my last update!)
